Financial support for delegates

The CDA is offering limited financial support for up to 20 delegates from the East and Southern African region. This support will be provided in accordance with the following rules:

- The national dental association must be a member of the CDA, with no current subscription payments outstanding.
- The national dental association must support the attendance of the individual through a letter to the CDA.
- No more than two individuals from each country can be funded.
- Agreement to funding is on a first-come-first-served basis (discretion to accept further applicants may be given only if the number of applicants is otherwise low).
- The funding available is limited to R2850 per delegate per night, which includes single accommodation, breakfast, lunch and dinner. In addition, a maximum of £150 (R2420) will be made available to support flight costs. No additional funding for travel, expenses, visa or hotel extras will be available.
- Costs will only be reimbursed once attendees have arrived at the workshop; cancellation of attendance will not be funded.

Delegates who are not seeking financial support or are not eligible for it are, of course, also welcome to attend this educational workshop. The cost to the individual is R2850 per night. This includes accommodation at the conference hotel for two nights and breakfast, lunch and dinner.

The event will provide 7 hours of continuous professional development.
